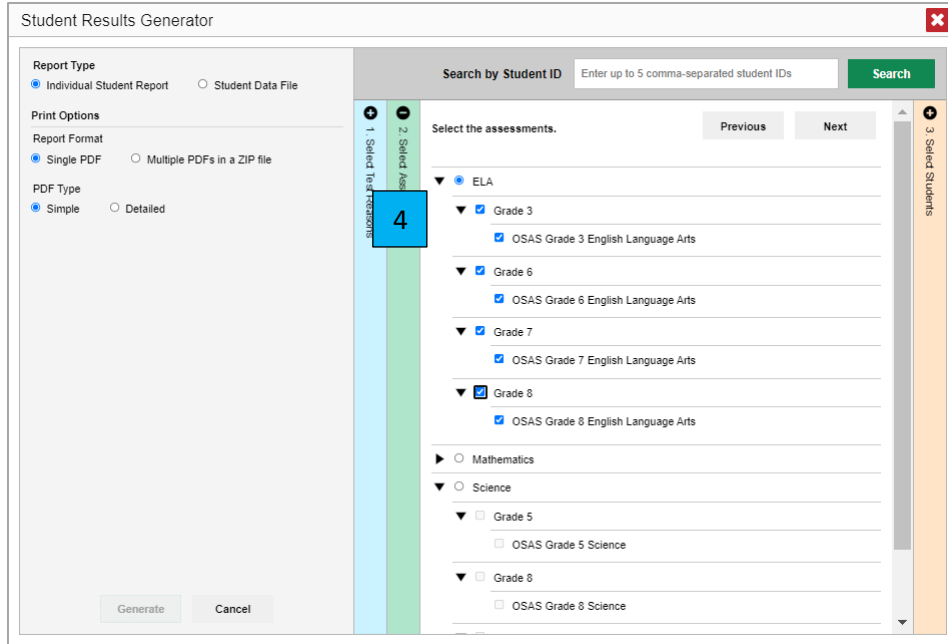


Centralized Reporting System (CRS) Updates to Student Results Generator

Beginning Monday, March 21, some functionality is being updated in the CRS Student Results Generator to improve system performance. Changes to the process for generating ISRs (PDF) and Student Data files (XLS, CSV or TXT) are summarized below.

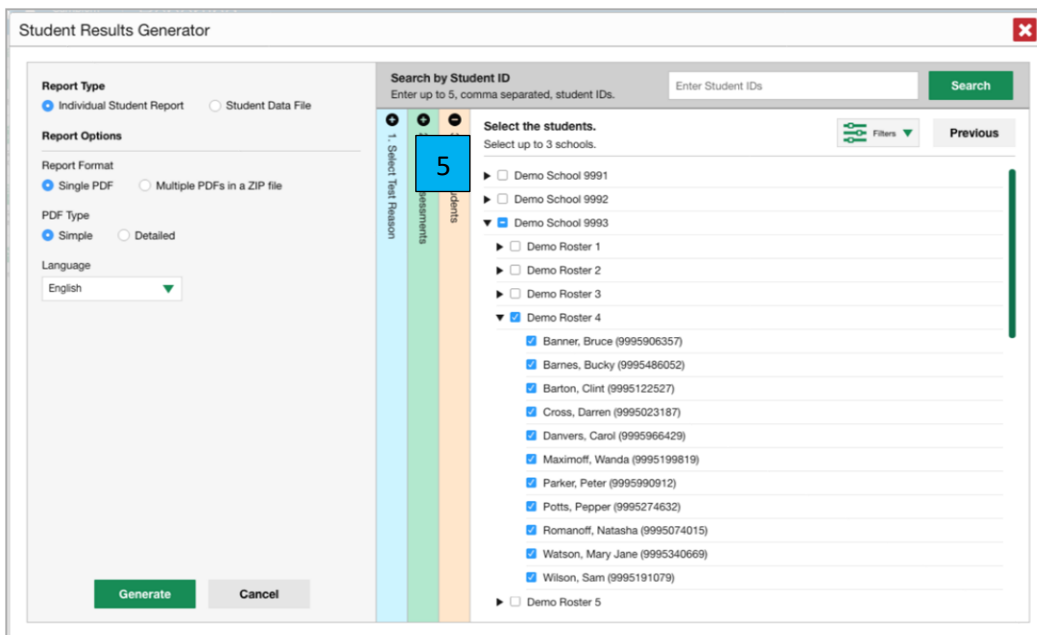

1. The Report Type panel has moved from the right side of the window to the left side, so users can select Report Type first, when generating results.
2. Users may now only select one test reason at a time, using the new radio buttons. Users can run multiple reports if needed to generate reports for different test reasons. This applies when generating ISRs or Student Data Files.
3. The count of selected students has been removed from the gray header.



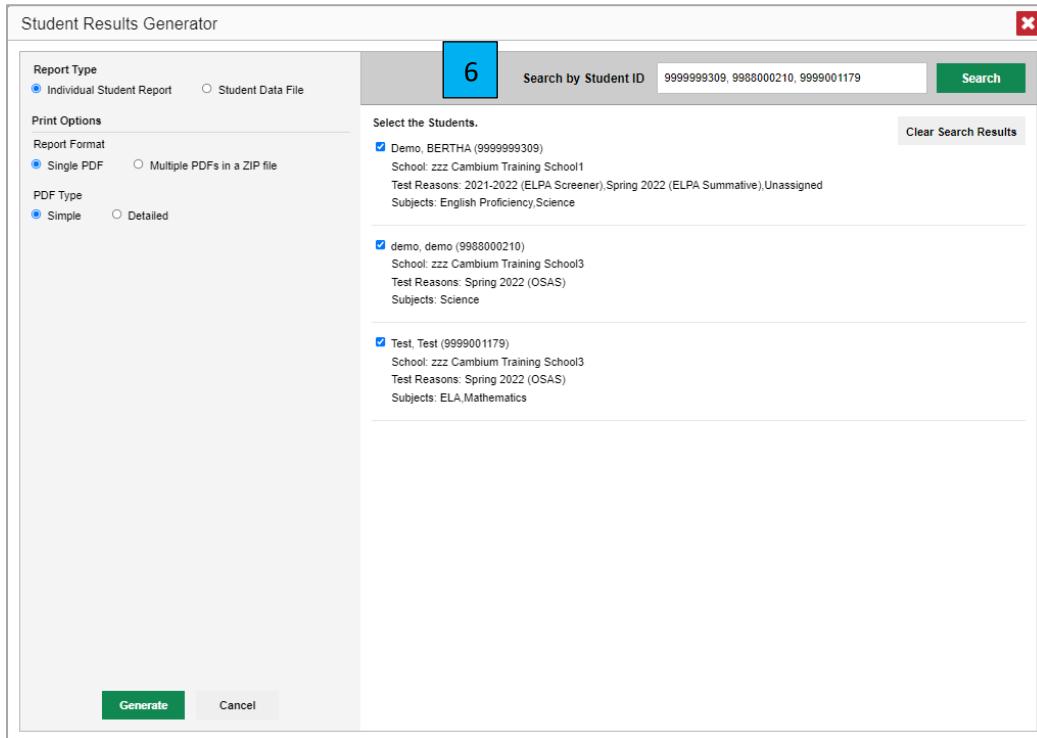
4. When generating ISRs, on the Select Assessment page, you can select **one subject** (and all the grades under it) or select grades/tests under that subject, using the subject radio button and checkboxes below. You can no longer select all subjects in one request.

When generating Student Data Files, you may continue to select **all subjects** (or drill down by specific subject, grade, or test).



- When generating ISRs, on the Select Students page, you can select **up to 3 schools**. You can no longer select all schools.

When generating Student Data Files, you can continue to select all students (or drill down by specific school, roster, or specific students.)



- You can now enter 5 SSIDs in the Search by Student ID field. Previously you could only search by one SSID at a time. The system will NOT limit your student ID search to one test reason and one subject.
